- You must complete question 5 to apply for a place in **any** state school in **any** area. You should therefore include the schools you wish to apply for in Wandsworth **and** any schools outside Wandsworth.
- You can use this form to apply for up to **six** state schools. Don't include private schools. You may only complete one form.
- You should apply for at least four schools to increase your options. If you apply for one or two schools only, it does
  not improve your chances of being offered a place. If your application is unsuccessful, you will be offered a place

- If your child can be allocated a place at **more than one** school, Wandsworth Council will offer you a place at **whichever of these** schools you put highest in your list in question 5. It is therefore very important that you list the schools in the right order as this cannot be changed later.

#### **Wandsworth Year 6 Test**

If your child attends a Wandsworth state primary school s/he will take the test at school on Thursday 21 September. If your child does not attend a Wandsworth state primary school and you are applying for a place at Ashcroft Technology Academy, Burntwood School, Chestnut Grove Academy, Ernest Bevin College or Graveney School you will need to register by 8 September to be invited to the Wandsworth Year 6 Test, which will be held on Saturday 23 September. Parents will be provided with the scores by mid-October.
