About Glass Door

Glass Door partners with churches to provide shelter and support to people experiencing homelessness. Our services are open to all. As London's largest emergency winter night shelter, Glass Door provides a safe, warm place to sleep for at least 100 men and women every night from November to early April. We are able to do this thanks to partnerships with churches across the boroughs of Hammersmith & Fulham, Kensington & Chelsea and Wandsworth. Guests of our emergency shelters also receive a hot supper and breakfast in the morning, cooked and served by volunteers. These free services are a life-line to those who would otherwise be sleeping on the street.






Week 3 of the new project rotations for Years 7,8,9 and it has been STEAM-tastic!

Year 7 STEAM Club:

In Mega Maths with Mr Sellars, the Year 7 STEAMmies enjoyed another excellent STEAM club session, this time learning about 'criminal penguins'. They looked at what questions to consider when building a mathematical model and applying this to finding the population of monkeys in the Amazon. Then they watched a video showing how some actual penguins stole rocks from other penguins in order to build their nests, which provided some humour too. They ended their session with a game that modelled different behaviours based on the probability of being a 'forager' or 'stealer'. Great enthusiasm from all!



Year 8 STEAM Club:

In Maths of Language with Mr Revelant, every language game has its own rules and the Year 8 STEAMMIES competed against each other in a game that allowed them to express their creativity with words but with a few morphological constraints. The "Code Breakers" team, chaired by fabulous linguist

This week's STEAM Academia session was led by Mr O'Sullivan, who presented about how the magnification of microscopes that use visible light is limited by the wavelength of the light they use. Sixth Form Parents' Evening


Please note that our Sixth Form Parents' Evening will take place at 6pm on Thursday 16 November.
